### Family update

I want to inform you that Billy, my son, is in United States. Last year he did not get a student visa to study in a US college. As he has a visitor visa, there is a possibility to change his current visa to a student visa. Please pray for the success of this process.

I have just published a new book. The title is: (word by word) "Toward an awakening of the civic consciousness of the Haitian" with a biblical approach. I have discovered and touched by many verses from the Bible regarding civism (Gen 2.5, Jer.29.7, Pr. 22.6, Mat.7.12....)

As a pastor, I preach about them in a Haitian context and decide also to expose them through a book into the country.

#### The political situation

The political situation is still the same. We had demonstrations the last 3 days. The country is still controlled by illegal armed people. The kidnapping is still there. Many people are kidnapped every day. The people have enough. The political sector is still unable to find an agreement to manage the Country for the wellbeing of the people.







#### **AFCA school:**

The children of 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 13<sup>th</sup> grade are getting ready for their official exam. We hope to have good results though the bad situation of the country.

I was really happy to participate in the graduation of a former student of AFCA school. Her name Guervanie Preal. She got her high school diploma at AFCA school. Now she is graduate student of a medical school. I am very proud of her.

The kindergarten (Preschool) needs a building for the children. We have worked on the estimation of the building. Il will cost approx. 100,000 \$

#### **AFCA Church**

We are planning to have our Easter conference. It will be stood from April 12 to 17. The topic: "Let us hold fast the profession of our Faith without wavering" (Heb 10.23)









## **Bethany Project**

The earthquake relief Funds: We praise the Lord for allowing brothers Jeremie and Peterson to go to Les Cayes on February 2, and provide funds to 12 families in order to fix their houses affected by the quake of August, 2021.

They have provided some cash to 6 persons to support their micro business. The beneficiaries had to buy the construction materials needed right away they have received the money.

They were really happy to receive this help. APCH, with the support of PWH, is glad to be a part of the effort to rebuild or fix some people houses in the South of Haiti. We thank US churches and individuals who provided funds to help these people.







#### 6-PROMOVAL
